- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.05, Penal Code, is amended by

- 8 intentionally or knowingly fails to provide support for:
- 9 (1) the individual's child younger than 18 years of

- 11 (2) [for] the individual's child who is the subject of a

- 13 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a)(2), a person knowingly
- 14 fails to provide support for the individual's child if the

- 16 initially receive the child support payment has not received the
- 17 payment on or before the due date specified by the court order.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this

- (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 22 Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the

- 1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
