3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Amend Chapter 314.004, Government Code as
5	follows:
6	314.004. [DYNAMIC FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT. (a) The board
7	shall prepare for each bill or resolution that raises or lowers a
8	tax or fee a dynamic fiscal impact statement.
9	(b) The dynamic fiscal impact statement must project cost
10	estimates based on dynamic scoring principles for a five-year
11	period that begins on the effective date of the bill or resolution.
12	(c) "Dynamic scoring principles" means a measurement of the
13	pace of economic growth or estimating the change in the aggregate
14	level of economic output and incomes using factors including:
15	(1) the direct impacts on program costs and tax
16	receipts;
17	(2) the effects on incentives to work, save, invest
18	and conduct economic affairs;
19	(3) the resulting change in the overall level of
20	<pre>economic activity;</pre>
21	(4) the impact of the higher or lower level of economic
22	activity on program costs and tax receipts; and
23	(5) a calculation of the net impact of the legislation

on the unified budget.

- 12 be attached to the bill or resolution immediately following [the

- 14 (1) the dynamic fiscal impact statement attached under
- 15 <u>Section 314.004, or</u>
- 16 (2)] the fiscal note attached under Section 314.003.
