- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 572.062 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 572.062. FORMER LEGISLATOR: LOBBYING RESTRICTED;</u>
- 8 CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) In this section, "administrative action,"
- 9 "communicates directly with," "legislation," "member of the
- 10 executive branch," and "member of the legislative branch" have the
- 11 meanings assigned by Section 305.002.
- 12 (b) A former member of the legislature may not, before the
- 13 <u>last day of the two-year term of the first legislature to convene</u>
- 14 after the date the person ceases to be a member, engage in
- 15 activities that require registration under Chapter 305.
- 16 (c) A former member who violates this section commits an
- offense. An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 572.062, Government Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to a member of the legislature who ceases to
- 20 be a member on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
