- 9 Act applies to a political subdivision [outside the boundaries of a
- 10 municipality | that has a regularly organized fire department not
- 11 consisting exclusively of volunteers, except a political
- 12 subdivision whose fire department is governed by another state law
- 13 providing for retirement benefits for <u>full-time paid</u> fire
- 14 department personnel. If the political subdivision's fire
- department consists partly of volunteers eligible to participate in
- 16 the program provided by Subtitle H, Title 8, Government Code
- 17 [Chapter 269, Acts of the 65th Legislature, Regular Session, 1977
- 18 (Article 6243e.3, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)], and partly of
- 19 employees, this Act applies to fire department personnel who are
- 20 employees.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
