3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle G, Title 6, Transportation Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 371 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 371. PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO MORE THAN
7	ONE TYPE OF TOLL PROJECT
8	Sec. 371.001. DISCOUNT PROGRAMS. (a) In this chapter:
9	(1) "Hybrid vehicle" means a motor vehicle that draws
10	propulsion energy from both gasoline or conventional diesel fuel
11	and from a rechargeable energy storage system.
12	(2) "Toll project" means a toll project described by
13	Section 201.001(b), regardless of whether the toll project is:
14	(A) a part of the state highway system; or
15	(B) subject to the jurisdiction of the
16	department.
17	(3) "Toll project entity" means an entity authorized
18	by law to acquire, design, construct, finance, operate, and
19	maintain a toll project, including:
20	(A) the department under Chapter 227 or 228;
21	(B) a regional tollway authority under Chapter
22	<u>366;</u>
23	(C) a regional mobility authority under Chapter
24	<u>370; or</u>

1	(D) a county under Chapter 284.
2	(b) A toll project entity shall establish a discount program
3	for electronic toll collection customers. The program must include:
4	(1) a 30 percent discount on the use of the entity's
5	toll project by an electronic toll collection customer whose
6	account relates to a hybrid vehicle; and
7	(2) the use of the entity's toll project for the
8	payment of a flat monthly rate, not to exceed 39.6 times the highest
9	toll charged by the entity for the use of the entity's toll project.
10	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
