1 (D) against a person the actor knows is a 2 security officer while the officer is performing a duty as a 3 security officer; or 4 (3) the actor: (A) knowingly discharges a firearm at or in the 5 6 direction of a habitation, building, or vehicle; 7 (B) is reckless as to whether the habitation, 8 building, or vehicle is occupied; and 9 (C) in discharging the firearm, causes serious 10 bodily injury to any person. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 11 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 12 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 13 covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 14 15 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed 16 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense 17 was committed before that date. 18
