- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 29.0021 to read as follows:
- Sec. 29.0021. STUDY OF STATE LAWS AND POLICIES RELATED TO

 SPECIAL EDUCATION. (a) The agency shall establish a committee

 composed of teachers, school administrators, parents, and other

 interested persons to study the state statutes, rules adopted under

 those statutes, and any related policies involved in the statewide
- design for delivery of services to children with disabilities in
- 13 this state.

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- 14 <u>(b) In studying the statutes, rules, and policies, the</u>
 15 committee shall:
- 16 <u>(1) determine whether a statute, rule, or policy is</u>
 17 required under federal law;
- 18 (2) determine the method or means to eliminate any
 19 statute, rule, or policy identified under Subdivision (1); and
- 20 (3) consider the fiscal impact to the state in
- 21 <u>maintaining</u> any statute, rule, or policy identified under
- 22 Subdivision (1).
- (c) Not later than July 1, 2008, the committee shall
- 24 recommend to the legislature and the commissioner any necessary

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- 1 changes to any statute, rule, or policy identified under Subsection
- 2 <u>(b)(1).</u>
- 3 (d) This section expires August 1, 2008.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
