A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a transitional health plan program for certain children
3	previously enrolled in the Medicaid or the state child health plan
4	program.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code, is amended by
7	adding Subchapter E to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER E. TRANSITIONAL CHILD HEALTH PLAN PROGRAM
9	Sec. 62.201. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH PROGRAM. The
10	commission may establish a transitional child health plan program
11	to provide health benefits coverage for children previously
12	enrolled in the medical assistance program under Chapter 32, Human
13	Resources Code, or the child health plan program under this chapter
14	who are no longer eligible for medical assistance or benefits under
15	those programs.
16	Sec. 62.202. ELIGIBILITY. A child is eligible for health
17	benefits coverage under the transitional child health plan program
18	if the child:
19	(1) is younger than 19 years of age;
20	(2) is not eligible for:
21	(A) medical assistance under the medical
22	assistance program under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code; or
23	(B) covered benefits under the child health plan

program under this chapter;

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- 1 (3) is not covered by a private health benefits plan 2 offering adequate benefits, as determined by the commission; and
- 3 (4) satisfies any other eligibility standard imposed
- 4 by the commission.
- 5 Sec. 62.203. BENEFITS COVERAGE. (a) Each health plan
- 6 provider that provides coverage under the child health plan program
- 7 shall offer health benefits coverage to a child determined to be
- 8 eligible for coverage under Section 62.202.
- 9 (b) A child remains eligible for those benefits until the
- 10 <u>ear</u>lier of:
- 11 (1) the first anniversary of the date the child
- enrolls in a health plan under Subsection (a); or
- 13 (2) the individual's 19th birthday.
- 14 Sec. 62.204. PREMIUM PAYMENTS. (a) The commission shall
- 15 determine the amount of the health plan premium for a child
- 16 participating in the transitional child health plan program under
- 17 this subchapter. The amount of the premium may not exceed the
- 18 premium amount paid by the state to cover a child enrolled in the
- 19 child health plan program.
- 20 (b) The commission may not pay any amount of the premium,
- 21 deductible, copayment, coinsurance, or other cost-sharing
- 22 obligation related to health benefits coverage offered under the
- 23 transitional child health plan program.
- 24 (c) A participant's health plan coverage under this
- 25 <u>subchapter shall be terminated on failure to make timely payments</u>
- of the premium to be paid for the coverage.
- Sec. 62.205. RULES; GUIDELINES. The executive

- 1 commissioner of the commission by rule shall establish:
- 2 (1) eligibility standards for participants in the
- 3 transitional child health plan program under this subchapter; and
- 4 (2) guidelines for premium payments for health plans
- 5 under the program.
- 6 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2008, the executive
- 7 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 8 adopt the rules and guidelines necessary to implement Subchapter E,
- 9 Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
