5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 426, Acts of the 64th 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 1975 (Article 6243k, Vernon's Texas 8 Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

9 Sec. 2. (a) An incorporated city or town may create a retirement, disability, and death benefit system for its appointive 10 11 officers and employees if a majority of the qualified voters of the 12 city or town voting on the proposition approve the creation at an 13 election called for that purpose. Each member of the system shall 14 contribute to the system an amount determined by the city or town, which, except as provided by Subsection (b), may not exceed 10 15 percent of the member's annual compensation paid by the city or 16 town, and the city or town shall contribute for each member an 17 amount that at least equals but is not more than twice the amount of 18 the member's contribution. A member of a municipal system is 19 eligible for disability benefits if he is disabled in the course of 20 21 his employment with the city or town. A member is eligible for 22 retirement benefits if he is 65 years old or older, or he is 60 years 23 old but less than 65 years old and has been employed by the city or 24 town for 25 years or more.

1	(b) Each member of a retirement, disability, and death
2	benefit system provided under this section by a city or town shall
3	contribute to the system an amount determined by the city or town
4	that may exceed 10 percent of the annual compensation paid to the
5	member by the city or town if the city or town:

7	(2) is located in a county:
8	(A) that has a population of 1.4 million or more;

10	(B) in which two or more cities or towns that each
11	have a population of 300,000 or more are predominately located.
12	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
