4	SECTION 1. Section 74.351, Civil Practices and Remedies
5	Code, is amended by adding subsections (d) and (e) to read as
6	follows:
7	(d) the court may, for good cause shown after motion and
8	hearing, extend any time period specified in Subsection (c) of this
9	section for an additional 30 days. Only one extension may be granted
10	under this subsection.
11	(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, if
12	a claimant has failed to comply with a deadline established by
13	Subsection (c) of this section and after hearing the court finds
14	that the failure of the claimant or the claimant's attorney was not
15	intentional or the result of conscious indifference but was the
16	result of an accident or mistake, the court shall grant a grace
17	period of 30 days to permit the claimant to comply with that
18	subsection. A motion by a claimant for relief under this subsection
19	shall be considered timely if it is filed before any hearing on a
20	motion by a defendant under Subsection (d) of this section.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
