5	SECTION 1. Subdivision (9), Section 551.003, Occupations
6	Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	(9) $\underline{(A)}$ "Compounding" means the preparation, mixing,
8	assembling, packaging, or labeling of a drug or device:
9	$\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(A)}}{\text{A}}$ ] as the result of a practitioner's
10	prescription drug order based on the
11	practitioner-patient-pharmacist relationship in the course of
12	<pre>professional practice;</pre>
13	$\underline{\text{(ii)}}$ [\frac{(B)}{B}] for administration to a patient
14	by a practitioner as the result of a practitioner's initiative
15	based on the practitioner-patient-pharmacist relationship in the
16	course of professional practice;
17	$\underline{\text{(iii)}}$ [ $\frac{\text{(C)}}{\text{)}}$ ] in anticipation of a
18	prescription drug order based on a routine, regularly observed
19	prescribing pattern; or
20	$\underline{\text{(iv)}}$ [\frac{\tau D}{D}] for or as an incident to
21	research, teaching, or chemical analysis and not for selling or
22	dispensing, except as allowed under Section 562.154 or Chapter 563.
23	(B) The term does not include the reconstitution
24	of commercial products or the addition of flavoring to a commercial

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- 1 product, provided the addition of flavoring is in accordance with
- 2 board rules.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
