- 5 SECTION 1. Section 643.252, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The department shall suspend a registration issued 8 under this chapter if a motor carrier fails to conduct alcohol and
- 9 drug testing of an employee who holds a commercial driver's license
- 10 under Chapter 522 under federal safety regulations as part of the
- 11 <u>motor carrier's drug testing program or consortium</u>, as defined by
- 12 49 C.F.R. Part 382. A suspension under this subsection continues
- 13 <u>until the motor carrier:</u>
- 14 (1) implements the program or consortium described by
- 15 this subsection; and
- 16 (2) completes the online course, "Drugs and Alcohol:
- 17 Keeping It Straight," provided by the federal Transportation Safety
- 18 <u>Institute.</u>
