1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to limitations on the compensation of county auditors for  
1-10 certain counties.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 152.032(d), Local Government Code, is  
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (b), in a county with a  
1-15 population of more than 77,000 and less than 80,000, or 500,000 or  
1-16 more the amount of the compensation and allowances of a county  
1-17 auditor may be set in an amount that exceeds the limit established  
1-18 in Subsection (a) if the compensation and allowances are approved  
1-19 by the commissioners court of the county.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
