A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an annual report on hospital infection rates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.076 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 1001.076. INFECTION RATES. (a) To protect the public
7	health and safety, the executive commissioner shall adopt rules and
8	procedures requiring hospitals licensed under Chapter 241, and any
9	other health care facility that the executive commissioner requires
10	by rule to comply with this section, to annually publish and make
11	available to the public a report on hospital infection rates. In
12	adopting the rules, the executive commissioner shall:
13	(1) determine the infections that must be reported and
14	the procedures for documenting and maintaining a record of the
15	infection rates for the annual report;
16	(2) determine the health care facilities that must
17	report the infections;
18	(3) establish the methods a health care facility is
19	required to use in making the report available to the public;
20	(4) determine the sanctions and penalties a health
21	care facility is subject to for failing to comply with the reporting
22	requirements; and
23	(5) provide any other procedures or rules the
24	executive commissioner considers necessary for implementing this

- 2 (b) A hospital, and any other health care facility required
- 3 by rule to report under this section, must file a copy of the report
- 4 with the department not later than January 31 of each year on the
- 5 infection rates at the hospital or facility during the previous
- 6 year.
- 7 (c) In a report provided under Subsection (b), a hospital or
- 8 health care facility may not individually identify any patient or
- 9 health care professional. Any information collected by a hospital
- or health care facility that individually identifies a patient or
- 11 health care professional is confidential and not subject to
- 12 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, is not subject to
- subpoena, and may not otherwise be released or made public except as
- 14 provided by rules adopted under this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 16 Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to
- implement Section 1001.076, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- this Act, not later than January 1, 2008.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
