A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the prevention of groundwater contamination by swimming
3	pool and spa chemicals; providing a penalty.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 5, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 380 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 380. MISCELLANEOUS SOURCES OF POLLUTION
8	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 380.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "commission"
10	means the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
11	[Sections 380.002-380.050 reserved for expansion]
12	SUBCHAPTER B. POOL AND SPA CHEMICALS
13	Sec. 380.051. INSPECTION REQUIRED. (a) The commission by
14	rule shall require each newly constructed or substantially altered
15	in-ground swimming pool or spa to pass an inspection before the pool
16	or spa is first filled after construction or alteration to ensure
17	that the structure and its associated plumbing and equipment are
18	constructed in a manner that will prevent the contamination of
19	groundwater by pool or spa chemicals.
20	(b) An inspection required under Subsection (a) must be
21	conducted by a county or municipal regulatory authority having
22	jurisdiction over the pool or spa.
23	Sec. 380.052. FEE. The regulatory authority conducting the
24	inspection shall impose on the owner of an in-ground swimming pool

- 1 or spa a fee for an inspection under this subchapter. The
- 2 regulatory authority by order shall establish the amount of the
- 3 fee, which may not exceed the cost of conducting the inspection.
- 4 Sec. 380.053. POOL OR SPA WATER DISCHARGE; OFFENSE. (a) A
- 5 person may not knowingly discharge chemically treated water from a
- 6 swimming pool or spa in the course of draining or maintaining the
- 7 pool or spa to a location other than into a sanitary sewer.
- 8 (b) A person who violates Subsection (a) commits an offense.
- 9 <u>(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), an offense under</u>
- 10 this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 11 (d) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor
- 12 if it is shown on the trial of the defendant for an offense under
- 13 this section that the defendant has previously been convicted of an
- 14 offense under this section.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission on Environmental
- 16 Quality shall adopt the rules required by Subchapter B, Chapter
- 17 380, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 18 January 1, 2008.
- 19 (b) The inspection requirements under Section 380.051,
- 20 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, apply only to an
- 21 in-ground pool or spa for which construction or alteration begins
- 22 on or after March 1, 2008.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
