A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to using county election precincts in every county for any 3 election held on the November uniform election date.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.002(a), Election Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The county election precincts are the election 8 precincts for the following elections:
- 9 (1) the general election for state and county 10 officers;
- 11 (2) a special election ordered by the governor;
- 12 (3) a primary election;

- 13 (4) a countywide election ordered by the commissioners
- 14 court, county judge, or other county authority, except an election
- subject to Section 42.062(2); and
- 16 (5) as provided by Section 42.0621, any other election
- 17 held on the November uniform election date of:
- 18 (A) a school district located in any county; and
- 19 (B) a political subdivision, other than a school
- 20 <u>district</u>, not located in a county with a population of more than 3.3
- 21 million or a county adjacent to a county with a population of more
- 22 than 3.3 million [held on the November uniform election date, as
- 23 provided by Section 42.0621].
- SECTION 2. Section 42.0621(a), Election Code, is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- 2 (a) In an election held on the November uniform election
- 3 date, the [participating] political subdivisions described by
- 4 Section 42.002(a)(5) [not located in a county with a population of
- 5 more than 3.3 million or a county adjacent to a county with a
- 6 population of more than 3.3 million] shall use the regular county
- 7 election precincts.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 43.004(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (b) If a political subdivision [not located in a county with
- 11 a population of more than 3.3 million or a county adjacent to a
- 12 county with a population of more than 3.3 million] holds an election
- on the November uniform election date and is required to use the
- 14 <u>regular county election precincts</u>, the political subdivision shall
- designate as the polling places for the election the regular county
- 16 polling places in the county election precincts that contain
- 17 territory from the political subdivision.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
