9	that holds its election for trustees on the same date as the general
10	election for state and county officers is exempt from complying
11	with a requirement relating to:
12	(1) elementary school class size as provided by
13	Section 25.112, subject to Subsection (b);
14	(2) the first day of instruction as provided by
15	Section 25.0811;
16	(3) the assessment process and professional growth
17	activities for principals as provided by Section 21.054(b);
18	(4) annual field testing of questions for assessment
19	instruments administered under Subchapter B, Chapter 39, subject to
20	Subsection (c); and
21	(5) the size of:
22	(A) a library as adopted under Section 33.021 or
23	other law; or
24	(B) a computer lab.

1	(b) A school district to which this section applies must
2	comply with the elementary school class size requirements of
3	Section 25.112 as determined on a campus-based or district-based
4	average of students per class.
5	(c) A school district to which this section applies must
6	comply once every three years with the requirements relating to
7	field testing of questions for assessment instruments administered
8	under Subchapter B, Chapter 39.
9	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
10	school year.
11	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
