22	SECTION 2. (a) This Act applies only to the following that
23	are filed on or after the effective date of this Act:
24	(1) an application for a building permit or

1 registration or certification as a builder; or

2 (2) a request for state-sponsored inspection and3 dispute resolution.

4 (b) An application for a building permit or for registration 5 or certification as a builder or a request for state-sponsored 6 inspection and dispute resolution that was filed before the 7 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed 8 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is 9 continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
