11	(b) Electric utilities operating in the state which are
12	subject to traditional cost of service rate regulation and
13	currently have a transition to competition plan on file at the
14	commission shall, within 180 days of the effective date of this
15	Section:
16	(1) withdraw such plan from the commission;
17	(2) cease all activities related to such plan; and
18	(3) file with the commission for recovery of any costs
19	incurred as a result of the preparation, filing and pursuit of such
20	plan.
21	(c) This section shall prevail over any conflicting
22	provision or provisions in this subchapter.
