- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 391.068, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the [The]
- 9 commission shall issue a permit to a person with a license issued
- 10 under this subchapter:
- 11 (1) whose license application complies with rules
- 12 adopted under Section 391.065; and
- 13 (2) whose outdoor advertising, whether owned or
- 14 leased, if erected would comply with this chapter and rules adopted
- 15 under Section 391.032(a).
- 16 (d) In addition to the requirements of Subsection (a), if
- 17 the outdoor advertising is located within the jurisdiction of a
- 18 political subdivision that is exercising its authority to regulate
- 19 <u>outdoor advertising</u>, the commission may issue a permit under this
- 20 <u>section only if the political subdivision:</u>
- 21 (1) has not acted to prohibit new outdoor advertising
- 22 within the jurisdiction of the political subdivision; and
- 23 (2) has issued a permit authorizing the outdoor
- 24 advertising.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 394.021, Transportation Code, is amended
- 2 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (c) If the off-premise sign is located within the
- 4 jurisdiction of a political subdivision that is exercising its
- 5 authority to regulate off-premise signs, the commission may not
- 6 issue a permit under this section if the political subdivision has
- 7 acted to prohibit new off-premise signs within the jurisdiction of
- 8 the political subdivision.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 394.022, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 394.022. ISSUANCE OF PERMIT. The commission shall
- issue a permit to a person:
- 13 (1) whose application complies with commission rule;
- 14 (2) [and] whose sign, if erected, would comply with
- the requirements of this chapter; and
- 16 (3) who, if the off-premise sign is located within the
- 17 jurisdiction of a political subdivision that is exercising its
- authority to regulate off-premise signs, has obtained a permit for
- 19 the off-premise sign.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
