## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to occupancy limits for certain residential rental
- 3 property.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 92.010(a) and (b), Property Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the maximum number
- 8 of adults that a landlord may allow to occupy a dwelling is  $\underline{\mathsf{two}}$
- 9 [three] times the number of bedrooms in the dwelling.
- 10 (b) A landlord may allow an occupancy rate of more than  $\underline{\text{two}}$
- 11 [three] adult tenants per bedroom:
- 12 (1) to the extent that the landlord is required by a
- 13 state or federal fair housing law to allow a higher occupancy rate;
- 14 or
- 15 (2) if an adult whose occupancy causes a violation of
- 16 Subsection (a) is seeking temporary sanctuary from family violence,
- 17 as defined by Section 71.004, Family Code, for a period that does
- 18 not exceed one month.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a lease or lease agreement executed or renewed on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. A lease or lease agreement executed or
- 22 renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 23 in effect at the time the lease or lease agreement was executed or
- renewed, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
