4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 824.603, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 824.603. EXCLUSION FROM CREDIT. Employment of a
- 8 retiree described by Section 824.602(a) does not entitle a retiree
- 9 to additional service credit, and, except as provided by Section
- 10 <u>825.4092</u>, the retiree so employed is not required to make
- 11 contributions to the system from compensation for that employment.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 825.4092, Government Code, is amended by
- amending Subsections (b) and (e) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 14 (f) to read as follows:

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- 15 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (e), during each
- 16 payroll period for which a retiree is reported:
- 17 (1) $[\tau]$ the employer shall contribute to the retirement
- 18 system for each retiree reported an amount based on the retiree's
- 19 salary equal to [$\frac{\text{the sum of }}{\cdot}$
- [(1) the current contribution amount that would be
- 21 contributed by the retiree if the retiree were an active,
- 22 contributing member; and
- 23 $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ the current contribution amount authorized by
- 24 the General Appropriations Act that the state would contribute for

- 1 that retiree if the retiree were an active, contributing member;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) each retiree reported shall contribute to the
- 4 retirement system an amount based on the retiree's salary equal to
- 5 the current contribution amount that would be contributed by the
- 6 retiree if the retiree were an active, contributing member.
- 7 (b-1) In addition to the amounts contributed under
- 8 Subsection (b) and except as provided by Subsection (e), during
- 9 <u>each payroll period for which an employer reports a retiree</u>
- 10 employed in a position other than as a full-time librarian, a
- 11 <u>full-time</u> counselor, a full-time school nurse, or a classroom
- 12 teacher described by Section 5.001, Education Code, the employer
- shall contribute to the retirement system for the retiree an amount
- 14 based on the retiree's salary equal to the current contribution
- amount that would be contributed by the retiree if the retiree were
- 16 <u>an active, contributing member.</u>
- 17 (e) The amounts required to be paid under Subsections (b),
- 18 (b-1), and (c) are not required to be paid by a reporting employer
- 19 for a retiree who was reported under the retirement system rules in
- 20 effect for the report month of January 2005 by:
- 21 (1) that reporting employer; or
- 22 (2) another employer, if both employers are school
- 23 districts that consolidated into a consolidated school district on
- or before September 1, 2005.
- 25 (f) A retiree's contribution under this section shall be
- 26 made in the same manner as a member's contribution is collected
- 27 under Section 825.403. Except as provided by Section 824.602, a

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- 1 retiree who makes contributions as required by this section is not
- 2 <u>entitled to receive a monthly benefit payment during the period the</u>
- 3 <u>retiree is employed in a Texas public education institution.</u> The
- 4 retiree is not entitled to additional service credit for the period
- 5 the retiree is employed as described by this section.
- 6 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply
- 7 beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
