- 5 SECTION 1. Article 26.13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended by adding Subsection (a)(6) to read as follows:
- 7 (6) the fact that if the defendant is convicted of an offense under Section 22.01, Penal Code, punishable as a Class A 9 misdemeanor and involving a member of the defendant's family or 10 household, it may be unlawful for the defendant to possess a firearm or ammunition, pursuant to federal law under 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(9) or 12 state law under Section 46.04, Penal Code.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 1, Article 42.01, Code of Criminal
- 14 Procedure, is amended by adding Paragraph 30 to read as follows:
- 15 <u>30. In the event that the defendant has been convicted of an</u> 16 offense under Section 22.01, Penal Code, punishable as a Class A
- offense under Section 22.01, Penal Code, punishable as a Class A
 misdemeanor and involving a member of the defendant's family or
- 18 household, it may be unlawful for the defendant to possess a firearm
- or ammunition, pursuant to federal law under 18 U.S.C. 922(g)(9) or
- 20 <u>state law under Section 46.04, Penal Code.</u>
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
