H.B. No. 3044

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the authority of a county to issue bonds to establish drug and alcohol rehabilitation facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1301.001(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The commissioners court of a county may issue bonds authorized under Subtitle A and Chapter 1251 to:

(1) build a county courthouse or jail;

(2) purchase suitable sites in the county and to construct buildings on the sites for homes or schools for dependent or delinquent children;

(3) establish county facilities for needy or indigent persons in the county;

(4) purchase and construct bridges for public purposes in the county or to cross a stream serving as the county's boundary line; ~~or~~

(5) improve and maintain the public roads in the county; or

(6) establish drug-related or alcohol-related rehabilitation facilities.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
