11	date of the first conviction, the offense is a misdemeanor
12	punishable by a fine of not less than \$25 or more than \$200; and
13	[ <del>(2) for a third or subsequent conviction within one</del>
14	year after the date of the second conviction the offense is a
15	misdemeanor punishable by:
16	$[(A)]$ a fine of not less than $\frac{100}{25}$ or more
17	than \$500;
18	(2) [ <del>(B)</del> ] confinement in the county jail for not less
19	than 72 hours or more than six months; or
20	(3) $[(C)]$ both the fine and confinement.
21	SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
22	only to the punishment for an offense committed on or after
23	September 1, 2007. For purposes of this section, an offense is
24	committed before September 1, 2007, if any element of the offense

1 occurs before September 1, 2007.

2 (b) An offense committed before September 1, 2007, is 3 governed by the law in effect on the date that the offense was 4 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 5 purpose.
