- 2 this Act and the waste remains abandoned on the property on the

- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
