H.B. No. 3083

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of a judicial district in Grayson County and to the composition of the 6th Judicial District and the 336th Judicial District.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 24.542 to read as follows:

Sec. 24.542. 397TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (GRAYSON COUNTY). The 397th Judicial District is composed of Grayson County.

SECTION 2. Effective January 1, 2010, the heading to Section 24.106, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24.106. 6TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (~~[FANNIN]~~ LAMAR~~[7]~~ AND RED RIVER COUNTIES).

SECTION 3. Effective January 1, 2010, Section 24.106(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The 6th Judicial District is composed of ~~[Fannin]~~ Lamar~~[7]~~ and Red River counties.

SECTION 4. Effective January 1, 2010, Section 24.482, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 24.482. 336TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (FANNIN COUNTY ~~[AND GRAYSON COUNTIES]~~). ~~[(a)]~~ The 336th Judicial District is composed of Fannin County ~~[and Grayson counties]~~.

SECTION 5. (a) The local administrative district judge for the 6th Judicial District:

1 (1) shall transfer all cases from Fannin County that
2 are pending in the 6th District Court on January 1, 2010, to the
3 336th District Court; and

4 (2) may transfer any case from Fannin County that is
5 pending or filed in the 6th District Court on or after September 15,
6 2008, to the 336th District Court.

7 (b) When a case is transferred as provided by Subsection (a)
8 of this section, all processes, writs, bonds, recognizances, or
9 other obligations issued from the 6th District Court are returnable
10 to the 336th District Court as if originally issued by that court.
11 The obligees on all bonds and recognizances taken in and for the 6th
12 District Court and all witnesses summoned to appear in the 6th
13 District Court are required to appear before the 336th District
14 Court as if originally required to appear before that court.

15 SECTION 6. (a) The local administrative district judge for
16 the 336th Judicial District:

17 (1) shall transfer all cases from Grayson County that
18 are pending in the 336th District Court on January 1, 2010, to the
19 397th District Court; and

20 (2) may transfer any case from Grayson County that is
21 pending or filed in the 336th District Court on or after September
22 15, 2008, to the 397th District Court.

23 (b) When a case is transferred as provided by Subsection (a)
24 of this section, all processes, writs, bonds, recognizances, or
25 other obligations issued from the 336th District Court are
26 returnable to the 397th District Court as if originally issued by
27 that court. The obligees on all bonds and recognizances taken in

1 and for the 336th District Court and all witnesses summoned to
2 appear in the 336th District Court are required to appear before the
3 397th District Court as if originally required to appear before
4 that court.

5 SECTION 7. The 397th Judicial District is created on
6 September 15, 2008.

7 SECTION 8. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
