14	by adding Section 4.207 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 4.207. LIMITATION OF ACTIONS. A statute of
16	limitations applicable to an action asserting a claim for relief
17	under an agreement under this subchapter is tolled during the
18	marriage of the parties to the agreement. However, equitable
19	defenses limiting the time for enforcement, including laches and
20	estoppel, are available to either party.
21	SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
22	agreement under Subchapter B or C, Chapter 4, Family Code, without
23	regard to whether the agreement was made before, on, or after the
24	effective date of this Act.
