2	relating to the time for affiliation with a political party.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 162, Election Code, is amended by adding
5	Section 162.0095 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 162.0095. AFFILIATION PROCEDURE: PRESIDENTIAL
7	PRIMARY ELECTION. (a) This section applies only to a person
8	desiring to affiliate with a political party between:
9	(1) the first day on which an application for a place
10	on the election ballot for the general primary election held in the
11	same year in which the presidential primary election is held may be
12	filed; and
13	(2) the date of the presidential primary election.
14	(b) A person may affiliate with a political party by
15	registering with the party as provided by party rule. The rules
16	must allow a person to submit the registration electronically, by
17	mail, or in person at locations provided by the rules.
18	(c) The form of the registration must include:
19	(1) a space for the person's name, address, county of
20	registration, and voter registration number; and
21	(2) the following statement to be signed by the voter:
22	"I swear that I have not voted in a primary election or participated
23	in the convention of another party during the voting year."
24	(d) The form of the registration may include a space for:

1	(1) the person's e-mail address or phone number; and
2	(2) an affirmation of support for a candidate listed
3	on the ballot in the presidential primary election.
4	(e) Notwithstanding Section 162.010, an affiliation made
5	under this section is effective from the date of the registration
6	until the end of the voting year in which the presidential primary
7	election is held.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
