A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the administration of political party precinct, county,
- 3 and senatorial district conventions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 174.022(a), (b), and (c), Election
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A political party may provide by rule for the place,
- 8 date, and hour for precinct conventions. If party rules do not
- 9 provide a date for [The] precinct conventions, the conventions
- shall be held on general primary election day in the regular county
- 11 election precincts. If party rules do not set the hour and place
- for a precinct convention, the county executive committee serving a
- 13 precinct for which the hour and place of the convention was not set
- 14 by rule, not
- 15 [(b) Not] later than the date of the regular drawing for
- 16 position on the general primary election ballot, [the county
- 17 <u>executive committee</u>] shall set the hour and place for convening the
- 18 [each] precinct convention [for the precincts served by the
- 19 committee]. If the county executive committee fails to do so, the
- 20 county chair shall set the hour and place.
- 21 (b) A precinct convention may meet at the same place as one
- or more other precinct conventions.
- (c) The date and hour set for convening shall be the same for
- 24 all precinct conventions and [the conventions] may not be earlier

- 1 than 7 p.m. [or later than 9 p.m.] Notwithstanding the hour set for
- 2 convening, the convention may not convene until the last voter has
- 3 voted at the precinct polling place.
- 4 SECTION 2. Sections 174.025(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A political party shall provide by rule a process for
- 7 the designation of the temporary chair of the precinct convention.
- 8 If the party does not provide a process for designation, the [The]
- 9 precinct chair is the temporary chair of the precinct convention
- 10 held under this subchapter.
- 11 (b) If the person designated as temporary [precinct] chair
- is absent, a person who is eligible to participate in the convention
- 13 may act as temporary chair.
- SECTION 3. Section 174.062, Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- Sec. 174.062. TYPE OF CONVENTION HELD. (a) A county
- 17 convention shall be held in a county if the county is not situated
- in more than one state senatorial district. A political party may
- 19 provide by rule for the division of the county by commissioners
- 20 precincts for the purpose of convening more than one county
- 21 convention in separate places.
- 22 (b) If a county is situated in more than one state
- 23 senatorial district, instead of a county convention a senatorial
- 24 district convention shall be held in each part of the county that is
- 25 situated in a different senatorial district, unless otherwise
- 26 provided by party rule. A political party may provide by rule for
- 27 the division of the senatorial district by commissioners precincts

- or state representative districts for the purpose of convening more
- 2 than one senatorial district convention in separate places.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 174.063, Election Code, is amended by
- 4 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the [The] county
- 7 and senatorial district conventions shall be held on the third
- 8 Saturday after general primary election day. However, if that date
- 9 occurs during Passover or on the day following Good Friday, the
- 10 conventions shall be held on the next Saturday that does not occur
- 11 during Passover or on the day following Good Friday.
- 12 (b) The date, hour, and place for the convening of [a]
- 13 county <u>and senatorial district conventions</u> [convention] shall be
- 14 set in the same manner as for the precinct conventions held under
- 15 this chapter. County and senatorial district conventions shall
- 16 convene at the same date and hour.
- 17 (d) A party may provide by rule that a county convention
- shall be held immediately following the precinct conventions, in a
- 19 <u>location where one or more of the precinct conventions is held.</u>
- SECTION 5. Section 174.065(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (a) A political party may provide by rule a process for the
- 23 <u>designation of the temporary chair for a county or senatorial</u>
- 24 district convention. If a party does not provide a process for the
- 25 designation by rule:
- 26 (1) the [The] county chair is the temporary chair of a
- 27 county convention held under this subchapter;

- 1 (2) for [. If] a senatorial district [is] situated in 2 more than one county, the senatorial district executive committee 3 member from each county is the temporary chair of the senatorial 4 district convention held in the territory that the committee member 5 represents; and
- 6 (3) for [. If] a senatorial district [is] not situated
 7 in more than one county, the chair of the district executive
 8 committee is the temporary chair of the senatorial district
 9 convention.
- SECTION 6. Section 174.063(c), Election Code, is repealed.
- 11 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
