- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.803, Education Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Each institution of higher education shall admit an
- 8 applicant for admission to the institution as an undergraduate

- 10 (1) is the child of a public servant listed in Section
- 11 615.003, Government Code, who was killed or sustained a fatal
- 12 <u>injury</u> in the line of duty; and
- 13 (2) meets the minimum requirements, if any,
- 14 established for purposes of this subsection by the governing board
- of the institution for high school or prior college-level grade
- point average and performance on standardized tests.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 18 beginning with admissions to general academic teaching
- 19 institutions for the 2008-2009 academic year. Admissions to a
- 20 general academic teaching institution before that academic year are
- 21 covered by the law in effect before the effective date of this Act,
- 22 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
