- SECTION 1. Section 109.58, Alcoholic Beverage Code, 5 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 109.58. RELAXATION OF RESTRICTIONS AS TO CHARITABLE 7
- EVENTS. (a) This code does not prohibit permit and license holders 8
- 9 engaged in the alcoholic beverage industry at different levels from
- jointly sponsoring a civic, religious, or charitable event, 10
- including by providing money, products, services, or other things 11
- 12 of value to a member of another level of the alcoholic beverage
- industry in conjunction with the event, provided that all of the 13
- proceeds from the sale or service of alcoholic beverages at the 14
- event benefit the civic, religious, or charitable organization. 15
- (b) The commission by rule may set definite limitations 16
- consistent with the general provisions of this code that relax the 17
- restrictions of this code with respect to the sponsoring of a civic, 18
- religious, or charitable event or the making of a gift to civic, 19
- religious, or charitable organizations by permit and license 20
- 21 holders engaged in the alcoholic beverage industry at different
- levels [the liquor or the wine industry]. 22
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
