## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of certain search warrants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Article 18.01(i), Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 In a county that does not have a judge of a municipal (i) court of record who is an attorney licensed by the state, a county 7 court judge who is an attorney licensed by the state, or a statutory 8 county court judge [in which the only judge serving the county who 9 is a licensed attorney is a district judge whose district includes 10 11 more than one county or in which the only judges serving the county 12 who are licensed attorneys are two or more district judges each of 13 whose district includes more than one county], any magistrate may 14 issue a search warrant under Subdivision (10) or Subdivision (12) of Article 18.02 of this code. This <u>subsection</u> [section] is not 15 applicable to a subsequent search warrant under Subdivision (10) of 16 Article 18.02 of this code. 17

SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a warrant issued on or after the effective date of this Act.

(b) A warrant issued before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the warrant was issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
