- SECTION 1. Section 74.061, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (h) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), the salary from the 7 state of a retired judge or justice assigned to a district court is
- 8 determined pro rata on the sum of the regular judge's salary from
- 9 the county plus the greater of:
- 10 (1) the regular judge's salary from the state on August
- 11 31, 2007 [1997]; or
- 12 (2) $\underline{100}$ [85] percent of the regular judge's salary from
- 13 the state, [or a greater percentage of that salary, not to exceed
- 14 100 percent, as established by the General Appropriations Act for
- 15 any fiscal year.
- 16 (i) Notwithstanding Subsection (d), the salary from the
- 17 state of a former judge or justice assigned to a district court is
- 18 determined pro rata on the greater of:
- 19 (1) the regular judge's salary from the state on August
- 20 31, 2007 [1997]; or
- 21 (2) 100 [85] percent of the regular judge's salary from
- 22 the state, [or a greater percentage of that salary, not to exceed
- 23 100 percent, as established by the General Appropriations Act for
- 24 any fiscal year.

- (j) A judge or justice who sits as an assigned judge for half a day or less shall be compensated in an amount that is equal to one-half of the amount to which a judge or justice is entitled for sitting as an assigned judge for a full day under this section.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
