- of more than 3.3 million shall acquire written authorization from
- 2 the owner of the property on which the unit, vendor, or
- 3 <u>establishment is operating.</u> The written authorization must:
- 4 (1) be notarized;
- 5 (2) provide that the operator has the property owner's
- 6 permission to operate the unit, vendor, or establishment on the
- 7 property; and
- 8 (3) be prominently displayed in the unit, vendor, or
- 9 establishment in plain view of the public at all times.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
