A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the calculation of certain fees collected to defray 3 certain expenses incurred in conjunction with the sale of a motor vehicle. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 348.006, Finance Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (e) to read 7 as follows: 8 The principal balance under a retail installment 9 (a) contract is computed by: 10 11 (1)adding: 12 (A) the cash price of the motor vehicle; 13 (B) each amount included retail in the 14 installment contract for an itemized charge; and subject to Subsection (c), a documentary fee 15 (C) for services rendered for or on behalf of the retail buyer in 16 preparing, handling, and processing documents and complying with 17 18 federal and state statutes and regulations, including those regarding security safeguards and reporting requirements, relating 19 to the motor vehicle and to the closing of the retail installment 20 21 transaction; and 22 (2) subtracting from the results under Subdivision (1) the amount of the retail buyer's down payment in money, goods, or 23 24 both.

1 (c) For a documentary fee to be included in the principal balance of a retail installment contract: 2 3 (1) the retail seller must charge the documentary fee 4 to cash buyers and credit buyers; 5 except as provided by Subsection (e), (2) the 6 documentary fee may not exceed $\frac{575}{50}$ for a motor vehicle retail 7 installment contract or a reasonable amount agreed to by the retail 8 seller and retail buyer for a heavy commercial vehicle retail installment contract; and 9 10 (3) the buyer's order and the retail installment contract must include: 11 12 (A) a statement of the amount of the documentary fee; and 13 14 (B) in reasonable proximity to the place in each 15 where the amount of the documentary fee is disclosed, the following notice in type that is bold-faced, capitalized, underlined, or 16 17 otherwise conspicuously set out from surrounding written material: "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE 18 IS NOT REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING 19 DOCUMENTS AND PERFORMING SERVICES RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF A 20 21 SALE. THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT THAT MAY BE CHARGED FOR A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS DETERMINED ACCORDING TO SECTION 348.006, FINANCE CODE. 22 [A] DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED \$50 FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE CONTRACT OR A 23 24 REASONABLE AMOUNT ACREED TO BY THE PARTIES FOR A HEAVY COMMERCIAL 25 **VEHICLE CONTRACT.**] THIS NOTICE IS REQUIRED BY LAW." 26 (e) Effective January 1 of each year, the Office of Consumer
