- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 301.004, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.004. ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS-ELECT; DUTIES OF CLERK.
- 8 (a) Under the direction of the secretary of state, the clerk shall
- 9 call the <u>districts of the appropriate house</u> [counties] in <u>numerical</u>
- 10 [alphabetical] order regardless of whether the secretary of state
- 11 has received the election returns for each district [county].
- 12 (b) If an individual appears at the call and presents proper
- 13 evidence of the individual's [his] election, the individual shall
- 14 be admitted or qualified as if the individual's election returns
- 15 had been made to the secretary of state.
- 16 (c) After the clerk has called the <u>districts</u> [counties] and
- 17 the members-elect have appeared and presented their credentials,
- 18 the clerk shall administer the official oath to each member-elect.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
