2	relating to expunction of a notice of lis pendens.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Property Code, is amended by adding
5	Section 12.0071 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 12.0071. MOTION TO EXPUNGE. (a) Except as provided by
7	this subsection, a court in which a proceeding is pending under
8	Section 12.007 shall, on the motion of a party to the proceeding
9	supported by an affidavit, order that the lis pendens for which a
10	notice of lis pendens has been recorded under Section 12.007 be
11	expunged. A court may not order a lis pendens expunged under this
12	subsection if the party that filed the notice proves to the court by
13	a preponderance of the evidence that:
14	(1) the proceeding affects:
15	(A) title to real property;
16	(B) the establishment of an interest in real
17	property; or
18	(C) the enforcement of an encumbrance against
19	real property described in the notice; and
20	(2) the person filing the notice commenced or
21	prosecuted the proceeding for a proper purpose and in good faith.
22	(b) Notice of a motion to expunge under Subsection (a) must
23	be served on each affected party on or before the 20th day before

the date of the hearing on the motion.

- 1 (c) The court shall rule on the motion for expunction based
- 2 on the affidavits and counteraffidavits on file and on any other
- 3 proof the court allows.
- 4 (d) After a certified copy of an order expunging a notice of
- 5 lis pendens has been recorded, the notice of lis pendens and any
- 6 information derived from the notice does not:
- 7 (1) constitute constructive or actual notice of any
- 8 matter contained in the notice or of any matter relating to the
- 9 proceeding; or
- 10 (2) create any duty of inquiry in a person with respect
- 11 to the property described in the notice.
- 12 (e) The court <u>in its discretion may require that the party</u>
- 13 prevailing in the expunction hearing submit an undertaking to the
- 14 court in an amount determined by the court.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a lis pendens filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 17 lis pendens filed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 18 by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
