- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1702.102(a), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Unless the person holds a license as a security services
- 7 contractor, a person may not:
- 8 (1) act as an alarm systems company, armored car
- 9 company, courier company, or guard company[, or guard dog company];
- 10 (2) offer to perform the services of a company in
- 11 Subdivision (1); or
- 12 (3) engage in business activity for which a license is
- 13 required under this chapter.
- SECTION 2. Section 1702.1056, Occupations Code, is amended
- by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (a-1) A locksmith company must register as required under
- 17 Section 1702.2225, but is not required to obtain a license under
- 18 this chapter.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 1702.109, Occupations Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1702.109. GUARD DOG COMPANY. (a) A person acts as a
- 22 guard dog company for the purposes of this chapter if the person
- 23 places, rents, sells, or trains a dog used to:
- 24 (1) protect an individual or property; or

- 1 (2) conduct an investigation.
- 2 (b) A guard dog company must register as required under
- 3 Section 1702.2223, but is not required to obtain a license under
- 4 this chapter.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 1702.116, Occupations Code, is
- 6 transferred to Subchapter J, redesignated as Section 1702.2223, and
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1702.223 [1702.116]. [QUALIFICATIONS FOR] GUARD DOG
- 9 COMPANY: REGISTRATION AND QUALIFICATIONS [LICENSE]; INSPECTIONS.
- 10 (a) Unless the person is registered as a guard dog company, a
- 11 person may not:
- 12 (1) act as a guard dog company;
- (2) offer to perform the services of a guard dog
- 14 company; or
- 15 (3) engage in business activity for which registration
- is required under this chapter.
- 17 (b) An applicant for a certificate of registration
- 18 [license] to engage in the business of a guard dog company must:
- 19 (1) meet the requirements under [of] Sections 1702.113
- and 1702.115 for a license applicant; and
- 21 (2) present evidence satisfactory to the commission
- 22 that the applicant will comply with the rules adopted under this
- 23 section.
- (c) [(b)] After consulting the [Texas] Department of State
- 25 Health Services, the commission shall adopt rules to ensure that
- the areas in which a guard dog company houses, exercises, or trains
- its animals are securely enclosed by a six-foot chain-link fence or

- 1 made equally secure.
- 2 (d) $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ The commission shall conduct regular inspections
- 3 to ensure compliance with the rules adopted under this section.
- 4 SECTION 5. Section 1702.3615, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subsections (a-1) and (b-1) to read as follows:
- 6 (a-1) The commission may revoke or refuse to grant or renew
- 7 <u>a registration if the applicant or registrant has been convicted</u>
- 8 of:
- 9 (1) a Class A misdemeanor or equivalent offense or a
- 10 greater offense that directly relates to the duties and
- 11 responsibilities of the registered occupation; or
- 12 (2) a Class B misdemeanor or equivalent offense that
- 13 <u>directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the</u>
- 14 registered occupation if the fifth anniversary of the date of the
- 15 <u>conviction has not occurred.</u>
- 16 (b-1) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter, the
- 17 commission's determination to revoke or refuse to grant or renew a
- 18 registration, license, or security officer commission on the basis
- of a criminal conviction must be made in accordance with Chapter 53.
- SECTION 6. Not later than December 1, 2007, the Texas
- 21 Commission on Private Security shall adopt the rules necessary to
- 22 implement the changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 1702,
- 23 Occupations Code.
- SECTION 7. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to
- 25 Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, apply only to an application for
- 26 issuance of an initial or renewal certificate of registration
- 27 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 (b) A person that holds a license as a guard dog company on
- 2 the effective date of this Act is not required to obtain a
- 3 certificate of registration as a guard dog company until the
- 4 person's license expires.
- 5 SECTION 8. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 6 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
- 7 (b) Sections 1702.2223 and 1702.3615, Occupations Code, as
- 8 amended by this Act, take effect January 1, 2008.
