## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a pilot program for the electronic
3	administration of assessment instruments in public schools.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 39.0235 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 39.0235. PILOT PROGRAM: ELECTRONIC ADMINISTRATION OF
8	ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS. (a) The commissioner shall establish a
9	pilot program to evaluate the feasibility of administering
10	assessment instruments required under Section 39.023
11	electronically through the use of personal digital assistant
12	devices.
13	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary for the
14	implementation of the pilot program. The rules must:
15	(1) define the scope of the program;
16	(2) establish a procedure and criteria for the
17	selection of school districts and schools for participation in the
18	program;
19	(3) establish a procedure and criteria for the

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(4) define the conditions applicable to distribution

selection of one or more vendors to provide equipment and services

necessary for the program, which procedure and criteria must

involve the selection of vendors on the basis of competitive

proposals submitted by prospective vendors;

- 1 and use of the personal digital assistant devices and associated
- 2 software necessary to provide for electronic administration of the
- 3 assessment instruments;
- 4 (5) establish procedures for contracting for,
- 5 purchasing, and distributing the personal digital assistant
- 6 devices and associated software to participating school districts
- 7 and schools; and
- 8 (6) provide for ensuring the security of the
- 9 electronic administration of the assessment instruments.
- 10 (c) Not later than December 1, 2010, the commissioner shall
- 11 submit a report evaluating the pilot program to the governor, the
- 12 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,
- 13 each member of the legislature, the Legislative Budget Board, and
- 14 the clerks of the standing committees of the senate and house of
- 15 representatives with primary jurisdiction over the public school
- 16 system.
- 17 (d) This section expires September 1, 2011.
- SECTION 2. Section 39.031(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) The cost of preparing, administering, including
- 21 administering through electronic means, or grading the assessment
- 22 instruments shall be paid from the funds allotted under Section
- 23 42.152, and each district shall bear the cost in the same manner
- 24 described for a reduction in allotments under Section 42.253. If a
- 25 district does not receive an allotment under Section 42.152, the
- 26 commissioner shall subtract the cost from the district's other
- 27 foundation school fund allotments.

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- 1 SECTION 3. In implementing the pilot program required by
- 2 Section 39.0235, Education Code, as added by this Act, the
- 3 commissioner of education shall, not later than the 90th day after
- 4 the effective date of this Act:
- 5 (1) define the scope of the project and the procedures
- 6 and criteria for selection of participating school districts and
- 7 schools; and
- 8 (2) complete the selection of vendors to be used in
- 9 administering the program.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
