H.B. No. 3236

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the service areas of the Blinn County College District
3 and the Austin Community College District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 130.162, Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 130.168. BLINN JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE AREA..
8 The service area of the Blinn College District includes the
9 territory within:

10 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes and
11 Waller, [~~Lee, and Fayette~~] counties;

12 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin independent
13 school districts located in Robertson County;

14 (3) Austin County, other than the territory within the
15 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;

16 (4) the Milano and Gause independent school districts
17 located in Milam County;

18 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
19 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery counties; [~~and~~]

20 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
21 that is located in Robertson County;

22 (7) the part of Lexington Independent School District
23 that is located in Williamson, Milam and Bastrop Counties;

24 (8) Lee county except the territory within the Elgin

1 Independent School District; and

2 (9) Fayette County except the territory within
3 Smithville Independent School District.

4 Sec. 130.166. AUSTIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE
5 AREA. The service area of the Austin Community College District
6 includes the territory within:

7 (1) ~~Bastrop~~, Hays, Gillespie, Caldwell, and Blanco
8 counties;

9 (2) Travis County, except the territory within the
10 Marble Falls Independent School District;

11 (3) Williamson County, except the territory within the
12 Florence, Granger, Hutto, Taylor, ~~and~~ Thrall, and Lexington
13 independent school districts; [~~and~~]

14 (4) Bastrop County, except the territory within the
15 Lexington independent school district;

16 ~~(4)~~ (5) the part of the Nixon-Smiley Consolidated
17 Independent School District located in Gonzales County;

18 (6) the part of the Elgin Independent School District
19 located in Lee County; and

20 (7) the part of Smithville Independent School District
21 located in Fayette County.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
26 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
