5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 161.0102 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 161.0102. VACCINES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM. (a) In this
9	section, "vaccines for children program" means the program operated
10	by the department under authority of 42 U.S.C. Section 1396s, as
11	amended.
12	(b) The department shall allow each health care provider
13	participating in the vaccines for children program to select
14	vaccines from the list of all vaccines that are:
15	(1) approved by the United States Food and Drug
16	Administration;
17	(2) recommended by the federal Advisory Committee on
18	Immunization Practices; and
19	(3) made available under contract with the Centers for
20	Disease Control of the United States Public Health Service.
21	(c) The department shall provide a vaccine selected by a
22	health care provider under Subsection (b) only if the cost to the
23	department of providing the vaccine is not more than 110 percent of

the lowest priced equivalent vaccine.

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- 1 (d) This section shall apply only to vaccines which are
- 2 <u>available from more than one manufacturer.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
