4	SECTION 1. Sections 388.003(a) and (b), Health and Safety

7	Energy Conservation Office shall adopt an energy code for
8	single-family residential construction and an energy code for all
9	other residential, commercial, and industrial construction. The
10	office shall ensure that the adopted energy codes will result in

12	conservation to be achieved by the codes prescribed by Subsection
13	(b) and shall periodically review and consider for adoption the
14	most recent revision of those codes.
15	(b) Until the energy codes are revised as provided by
16	Subsection (a):

18	energy efficiency chapter of the International Residential Code, as
19	it existed on May 1, 2001, is adopted as the energy code in this
20	state for single-family residential construction; and

22	[(b) To achieve energy conservation in all other

24	International Energy Conservation Code as it existed on May 1,

- 1 2001, is adopted as the energy code for use in this state for all
- 2 other residential, commercial, and industrial construction.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 388.005(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (c) Each political subdivision shall establish a goal to
- 6 reduce the electric consumption by the political subdivision by
- 7 five percent each year until December 31, 2012 [for five years,
- 8 beginning January 1, 2002].
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
