4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
7	(a-1) In addition to the allotment provided under
8	Subsection (a), a school district is entitled to an annual
9	allotment equal to the adjusted basic allotment multiplied by 0.1:
LO	(1) for each student in average daily attendance who:
L1	(A) has a parent or guardian serving on active
L2	duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States; and
L3	(B) has transferred to a campus in the district
L4	during the school year as a result of a change in residence because
L5	of an action taken under the Defense Base Closure and Realignment
L6	Act of 1990 (10 U.S.C. Section 2687); and
L7	(2) for each student in average daily attendance who
L8	has a parent or guardian who is serving on active duty in a combat
L9	zone as a member of the armed forces of the United States.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
