- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 204.006, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person's contribution rate for the calendar year in
- 8 which the person becomes an employer is the greater of:
- 9 (1) the rate established for that year for the major
- 10 group to which the employer is assigned under Section 204.004,
- 11 [less than one tenth of one percent]; or
- 12 (2) two and <u>seven-tenths</u> [<u>six tenths</u>] percent.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 204, Labor Code, is
- 14 amended by repealing Section 204.0625, Adjustment to
- 15 Relinquishment Tax Rate.
- SECTION 3. Chapter 204, Labor Code, is amended by repealing
- 17 Subchapter G, Employment and Training Investment Assessment;
- 18 Funds.
- 19 SECTION 4. Chapter 302, Labor Code, is amended by repealing
- 20 Subchapter F, Employment and Training Assessment.
- 21 SECTION 5. Subsection 303.003(a), Labor Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) To achieve the purposes of this chapter, the skills

- 1 [(1) money transferred into the fund under Section

- 5 SECTION 6. Upon the effective date, any money remaining in
- 6 the Employment and Training Investment Holding Fund under Section
- 7 204.122, Labor Code will be deposited into the Unemployment
- 8 Compensation Fund authorized under Subchapter B, Chapter 203, Labor
- 9 Code.
- 10 Upon the effective date, any money remaining in the Training
- 11 Stabilization Fund under Section 302.101, Labor Code will be
- 12 deposited into the Unemployment Compensation Fund authorized under
- 13 Subchapter B, Chapter 203, Labor Code.
- Money collected under Subchapter G, Chapter 204, Labor Code,
- 15 subsequent to the effective date will be deposited into the
- 16 Unemployment Compensation Fund authorized under Subchapter B,
- 17 Chapter 203, Labor Code.
- SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
