- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 28.004(a) and (b), Education Code, are 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The board of trustees of each school district \underline{may}
- 8 the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected

[shall] establish a local school health advisory council to assist

- 9 in the district's health education instruction.
- 10 (b) A school district must consider the recommendations of
- 11 the local school health advisory council, if one has been
- 12 <u>established</u>, before changing the district's health education

- 15 amended to read as follows:

- 20 SECTION 3. The following provisions are repealed:
