1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to classifying llamas, alpacas, and exotic livestock as
1-9 livestock under the Agriculture Code.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 1.003(3), Agriculture Code, is amended
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 (3) "Livestock" means cattle, horses, mules, asses,
1-14 sheep, goats, llamas, alpacas, exotic livestock, and hogs, unless
1-15 otherwise defined.

1-16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
