4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

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- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 61.0592 to read as follows:
- Sec. 61.0592 RESEARCH AND PROGRAM TO FOCUS ON MINORITY

 8 STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT. (a) The board may enter into an agreement with

 9 a foundation that is a 501(c)3, non-profit educational leadership

 10 organization to:
- 11 (1) conduct, coordinate, collect, and evaluate

 12 research relating to eliminating educational and other achievement

 13 gaps among ethnic and racial minority students, with a particular

 14 focus on eliminating achievement gaps among African American

 15 students, and
- 16 (2) develop programs, policies, and strategies to
 17 address those achievement gaps.
- 18 <u>(3) the foundation shall report its findings,</u>
 19 <u>including recommendations, to the agency by a date adopted by the</u>
 20 <u>agency.</u>
- 21 <u>(b) The board shall present to the legislature and the</u> 22 governor a report under Subsection (a)(3).
- 23 (c) The foundation or board may solicit and accept gifts and grants from any public or private source for the benefit of this

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- 1 <u>research.</u>
- 2 (d) The board may use money appropriated for the purposes of
- 3 this section and any gifts and grants received by the agency or
- 4 foundation under Subsection (c) for the establishment and operation
- 5 of the research project.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
