- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.302(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A vehicle shall display each lighted lamp and
- 8 illuminating device required by this chapter to be on the vehicle:
- 9 (1) at nighttime; [and]
- 10 (2) when light is insufficient or atmospheric
- 11 conditions are unfavorable so that a person or vehicle on the
- 12 highway is not clearly discernible at a distance of 1,000 feet
- 13 ahead<u>; or</u>
- 14 (3) when, because of moisture, rain, snow, or other
- 15 obstructions caused by unfavorable atmospheric conditions
- 16 resulting in substantially reduced visibility, the operator of the
- 17 vehicle is making use of the vehicle's windshield wipers.
- SECTION 2. Section 547.603, Transportation Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- Sec. 547.603. WINDSHIELD WIPERS REQUIRED. A motor vehicle
- 21 shall be equipped with a device that is operated or controlled by
- the operator of the vehicle and that cleans moisture, rain, snow, or
- 23 other obstructions from the windshield. The device shall be
- 24 maintained in good working condition.
