AN ACT

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- 2 relating to health benefit coverage for children and grandchildren.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 846.260, Insurance Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 846.260. LIMITING AGE APPLICABLE TO [UNMARRIED] CHILD.
- 7 [If children] Children are eligible for coverage under the terms of
- 8 a multiple employer welfare arrangement's plan document, [any] and
- 9 <u>there is no</u> limiting age applicable to [an unmarried] <u>a</u>child of an
- 10 enrollee [is 25 years of age].
- SECTION 2. Section 1201.062, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:

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- 13 Sec. 1201.062. COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN CHILDREN IN INDIVIDUAL
- 14 OR GROUP POLICY OR IN PLAN OR PROGRAM. (a) An individual or group
- 15 accident and health insurance policy that is delivered, issued for
- 16 delivery, or renewed in this state, including a policy issued by a
- 17 corporation operating under Chapter 842, or a self-funded or
- 18 self-insured welfare or benefit plan or program, to the extent that
- 19 regulation of the plan or program is not preempted by federal law,
- 20 [that provides] must provide coverage for a child of an insured or
- 21 group member, on payment of a premium, and must provide coverage
- 22 for:
- 23 (1) each grandchild of the insured or group member [if
- 24 the grandchild is:

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1	[(A) unmarried;
2	[(B) younger than 25 years of age; and
3	(C) a dependent of the insured or group member
4	for federal income tax purposes at the time application for
5	coverage of the grandchild is made]; and
6	(2) each child for whom the insured or group member
7	must provide medical support under an order issued under Chapter
8	154, Family Code, or enforceable by a court in this state.
9	(b) Coverage for a grandchild of the insured or group member
10	may not be terminated solely because the grandchild is no longer a
11	dependent of the insured or group member for federal income tax
12	purposes.
13	SECTION 3. Section 1251.151, Insurance Code, is amended to
14	read as follows:
15	Sec. 1251.151. COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN GRANDCHILDREN. (a) A
16	group policy or contract of insurance for hospital, surgical, or
17	medical expenses incurred as a result of accident or sickness,
18	including a group contract issued by a group hospital service
19	corporation, that provides coverage under the policy or contract
20	for a child of an insured must, on payment of a premium, provide
21	coverage for any grandchild of the insured [if the grandchild is:
22	[(1) unmarried;
23	[(2) younger than 25 years of age; and
24	[(3) a dependent of the insured for federal income tax
25	purposes at the time the application for coverage of the grandchild
26	is made].
27	(b) Coverage for a grandchild of the insured under this

- 2 is no longer a dependent of the insured for federal income tax
- 3 purposes.
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 1251.152, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1251.152. OPTIONAL COVERAGE FOR SPOUSES AND
- 7 DEPENDENTS. (a) For purposes of this section, "dependent"
- 8 includes:
- 9 (1) a child of an employee or member [who is;
- 10 [(A) unmarried; and
- 11 [(B) younger than 25 years of age]; and
- 12 (2) a grandchild of an employee or member [who is;
- 13 [(A) unmarried;
- 14 [(B) younger than 25 years of age; and
- 15 [(C) a dependent of the insured for federal
- 16 income tax purposes at the time the application for coverage of the
- 17 grandchild is made].
- (b) A group accident and health insurance policy [may] must
- 19 provide coverage for the spouse or a dependent of an employee or
- 20 member.
- 21 SECTION 5. Section 1271.006, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 1271.006. BENEFITS TO DEPENDENT CHILD AND GRANDCHILD.
- 24 [(a) If children] Children are eligible for coverage under the
- terms of an evidence of coverage, [any] and there is no limiting age

In this chapter: 8 9 "Agent" means a person who may act as an agent for the sale of a health benefit plan under a license issued under Title 10 13. 11 (2) "Dependent" means: 12 a spouse; 13 (A) 14 (B) a child [younger than 25 years of age], 15 including a newborn child; (C) a child of any age who is: 16 17 (i) medically certified as disabled; and (ii) dependent on the parent; 18 an individual who must be covered under: 19 (D) 20 (i) Section 1251.154; or (ii) Section 1201.062; and 21 any other child eligible under an employer's 22 health benefit plan, including a child described by Section 23

- 8 Sec. 1575.003. DEFINITION OF DEPENDENT AND RELATED TERMS.
- 9 In this chapter:
- 10 (1) "Dependent" means:
- 11 (A) the spouse of a retiree;
- 12 (B) [an unmarried] a child of a retiree or
- 13 deceased active member [-if the child is younger than 25 years of
- 14 age], including:
- 15 (i) an adopted child;
- 16 (ii) a foster child, stepchild, or other
- 17 child who is in a regular parent-child relationship; or
- 18 (iii) a recognized natural child;
- 19 (C) a retiree's recognized natural child,
- 20 adopted child, foster child, stepchild, or other child who is in a
- 21 regular parent-child relationship and who lives with or has his or
- 22 her care provided by the retiree or surviving spouse on a regular
- 23 basis regardless of the child's age, if the child is mentally
- 24 retarded or physically incapacitated to an extent that the child is
- dependent on the retiree or surviving spouse for care or support, as
- 26 determined by the trustee; or
- 27 (D) a deceased active member's recognized

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- 1 natural child, adopted child, foster child, stepchild, or other

- 6 provided by the active member on a regular basis; and
- 7 (ii) was mentally retarded or physically
- 8 incapacitated to an extent that the child was dependent on the
- 9 active member or surviving spouse for care or support, as
- 10 determined by the trustee.
- 11 SECTION 9. Section 1601.004, Insurance Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 1601.004. DEFINITION OF DEPENDENT. (a) In this
- 14 chapter, "dependent," with respect to an individual eligible to
- 15 participate in the uniform program under Section 1601.101 or
- 16 1601.102, means the individual's:
- 17 (1) spouse;
- 18 (2) [unmarried] a child [younger than 25 years of
- 19 age]; and
- 20 (3) child of any age who lives with or has the child's
- 21 care provided by the individual on a regular basis if the child is
- 22 mentally retarded or physically incapacitated to the extent that
- 23 the child is dependent on the individual for care or support, as
- 24 determined by the system.
- 25 SECTION 10. Sections 1201.065 and 1503.003, Insurance Code,
- 26 are repealed.
- 27 SECTION 11. The changes in law made by this Act apply only

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- to a health benefit plan, the contract or evidence of coverage for which is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A health benefit plan, the contract or evidence of coverage for which is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before the effective date of this Act, is covered by the law in effect at the time the contract or evidence of coverage is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed, and that law is
